**41 Leave of absence to employees of local authorities on
naval, military, or air service**

(1) For the purposes of this section the term **local authority** has the same meaning as in the Public Finance Act 1989.

- (2) Any local authority may grant leave of absence to any of its employees for the purpose of serving in any of Her Majesty's naval, military, or air forces, whether within New Zealand or elsewhere, and may, during such leave of absence, pay to every such employee or to his order the whole or any part of the salary or wages of that employee, at the rate at which he was employed at the commencement of his leave of absence.

The reference to the Public Revenue Act 1926 in subsection (1) was substituted for a reference to the Public Revenues Act 1953, as from 1 January 1954, pursuant to section 120(1) Public Revenues Act 1953 (1953 No 73). That reference was in turn substituted, as from 1 April 1978, by a reference to the Public Finance Act 1977, pursuant to section 163(1) Public Finance Act 1977 (1977 No 65). That reference was in turn substituted for a reference to the Public Finance Act 1989, as from 1 July 1989, pursuant to section 87 of the Public Finance Act 1989 (1989 No 44).
